Transportation Information

1. By Subway & Bus

1) Take Seoul subway Line 2 (Green Line) and get off at Seoul Nat'l Univ. station (Exit #3)

- Take 5511 Bus and pass through SNU Main Gate
- Take off the bus at Kisuksa Samgeori (Dormitory Junction)
- Follow the sign to the Education Information Hall (Building #10-1)

2) Take Seoul subway Line 2 (Green Line) and get off at Nakseongdae station (Exit #4)

- After stepping out the escalator, walk straight ahead, passing the gas station
- At the end of the gas station, make a left turn and go down the alley for about 30 meters
- Take Mini-bus #02 in front of the bakery on the right side.
- Get off at Kisuksa Samgeori (Dormitory Junction)
- Follow the sign to the Education Information Hall (Building #10-1)

3) Alternative carefree option: You can take a taxi at either Seoul National Univ. station or Nakseongdae station to Building #10-1. (Taxi fare: KRW 3,000 – 4,000)

2. By car

Pass through Rear Gate of Seoul National University. At the T-junction at top of the hill, turn right and then immediately get in to the left-turn lane to enter Gate 12 on the left. Enter the garage building and park your car on one of the three floors. The exit to the Education Information Hall is in the opposite direction of the entrance of the garage building.
